Lesson Name:	Apple Book
Objective:	Students will learn number correlation by copying and pasting the correct number of apple pictures using a PowerPoint created book to the poem Five Little Apples.
Subject/s:	Science/Math/Literacy
Grade Level:	PreK- K
Content Standard/s:	Math: Number, Number Sense and Operation #2,3 Reading Process #4,5 Writing Processes #7
Technology Standard/s:	Technology Foundation Standards for students #1,3
Materials:	PowerPoint Presentation with prepared slides and a graphic of an apple Apples by Gail Gibbons Poem Five Little Apples on Chart paper Crayons
Procedure:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Read the book <u>Apples</u> with the class, talk about the different colors apples come in. 2. Then read the poem Five Little apples as a class 3. After you have read the poem several times through you can move on to making the book version. 4. Before this lesson you will need to spend some time just showing your class PowerPoint and how to use the basic functions---show them just what they need to do this lesson – moving from one slide to another, copying, and pasting. 5. Open up the already created book template. 6. Then you need to show your students the copy key and model how to copy and paste pictures. 7. Have each student type his or her name on the line. 8. Students will then copy and paste the correct number of apples onto each page. 9. Then when the student is finished the book can be printed out and the student can color the apples to illustrate their books. Remembering that they should only color the apples the right colors, red, green, yellow, etc.
Evaluation:	<p>Students will be assessed to see if they put the correct number of apples on each page.
